

Open position: Editor, Co-Editor, and/or Associate Editor
The Faulkner Journal

The Editorial Board members of the *Faulkner Journal* invite nominations or self-nominations to replace the current general Editor and Associate Editor, both of whom will leave their positions on December 31, 2023.

The Board and the *Journal's* publisher, Johns Hopkins University Press, seek a scholar(s) with extensive knowledge of Faulkner's work and its reception, including the vast archive of work on one of the most well-researched figures in American literature. The position requires extensive attention and may compel institutional support (e.g., graduate student assistance or course-release time). JHUP covers all production costs. The Editor receives an annual \$1000 stipend; the Associate Editor receives \$500.

The current Editor contract was for a five-year term and we expect a similar period for the next Editor(s). The Associate Editor position was for two years, renewable.

One matter the incoming Editor(s) should consider is the relationship between the *Journal* and the William Faulkner Society, including the latter's role in furnishing members access to content via Project Muse and/or an issue's print edition.

Nominations for Editor, Co-Editor, or Associate Editor should include a brief statement describing a vision for maintaining and renewing the longstanding vitality of Faulkner scholarship.
